## (1) Beginning (one paragraph; one page max.)

- maybe few words about the author
- short summary of the book's main ideas and aims
- locating book in current or historical debate and in author's oeuvre
- Please provide information about the reviewed book in header to your review as in: Alexander Bird

## (2) Main part (2-3 pages)

- summary (for example chapter by chapter)

- summary of reviewer's critique and praise
- does the author achieve his or her goals?
- is his / her contribution valuable for the general debate?
- recommended readers: undergrads, graduate students, researchers?
